

Kosher Defined

Kosher foods and beverages are those products that conform and are allowed for consumption, based on the regulations of Jewish Dietary Law as prescribed in the Torah.



Reasons for food and beverages not being kosher, also include the presence of ingredients, flavours, or food chemicals, derived from non-kosher animals, or from kosher animals, that were not slaughtered in a ritually proper manner.

Also the use of non-kosher utensils and production machinery, as well as non-kosher production processes, result in a product ending up non-kosher.

KCS Certification Process



For your product or production facility to obtain kosher certification, please contact the KCS offices.

We will have a general review with you, and we will mail you a Kosher Certification Application Form. This form will give us the basic information we require, to discuss with you, your manufacturing process, as well as the details regarding ingredients and other specifics.

The major element of kosher certification is trustworthy supervision. The frequency and level of Rabbinic supervision comes in different levels. Some manufacturing processes require limited supervision, while others for instance when meat products are involved, a higher level of supervision is required.



Following this review we will prepare you a quotation, which will cover all costs and conditions for the overall certification process.

The fee, being part of the quotation, will be based on the scope of work by KCS staff, and will be reviewed with you.

Upon your acceptance, we will contact you for detailed information about the raw materials and ingredients. We will also arrange for a visit, by the Rabbi, to your facility, to review your production specifics, and to make a kosher production planning.



After this visit you will receive a confirmation, with the terms and conditions of the kosher certification. Upon acceptance we will make the KCS certification label available to you and you can submit the products labels, carrying the KCS label, for our final approval.

After completion of the of the certification you will receive a KCS Kosher Certification document.
